Emergency cell phone calls are routed to the closest 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP). The closest PSAP from the OWLS field is located in Marion County. Crucial time can be lost calling 911 from the field. For 911 calls from the OWLS field, please call the Levy Co. Sheriff& Office directly. The number is posted on the field& message board.

õWe often get emergency calls on our Administrative phone lines. However, it may be quicker to contact our agency at 352-486-5111 in lieu of dialing 911, reaching Marion County, and then having them transfer your call to Levy.ö




We asked Ted to help with a small section of our clubhouse wall. He went above and beyond for our club again and repaired multiple areas of the building.


Flight Feathers
