News from Charles...

Charles Montford wants to share information on some new planes he's bought and flown.

These are some of the new offerings of the Mini Model Warbird Series from Eachine. This is the P-51, F4U Corsair, and T-28 versions. Eachine offers other similar models. They are 400mm wingspan RC Model Airplanes made of EPP foam with pop off/on props. They have remotely switchable gyro stabilization systems, one key U-Turn return to home, one key aerobatics, preassembled, ready to fly, with everything needed in the box. These are very tough little models that just bounce off the grass with little or no damage. Small enough to store about anywhere in the original box.

At our Owl's flying field, they can be hand launched and landed in the grass on the runway with no damage other than the prop occasionally popping off. No big deal. More than enough power to hand launch. Very easy to fly because of the very small size and gyro system, aerobatics are limited. They fly for over fifteen minutes on a single battery charge. Each model comes with a 2.4Ghz transmitter that's easy to bind or they can be bound to a multi-protocol transmitter using Valantex's V761 protocol with autobind. With a little modification, the original box can be modified into a carrying case.

Handy, very tough, easy to fly little models
